BRIEF FORMATTING RULES

Margins must be at least one inch on each side of a page;

Typeface required:

No smaller than 14 points if serified, proportionally spaced typeface, such as Times New Roman. Footnotes must be no smaller than 12 points and headings no larger than 15 points.

Or;

No smaller than 12 points if serified, monospaced typeface, such as courier. Footnotes must be no smaller than 10 points and headings no larger than 14 points.

An appellant's and respondent's brief shall not exceed 14,000 words, and reply and amicus curiae briefs shall not exceed 7,000 words, inclusive of point headings and footnotes and exclusive of pages containing table of contents, table of citations, proof of service, certificate of compliance, or any authorized addendum containing statutes, rules, regulations, etc.

The procedure for seeking permission to file an oversize brief remains the same - a letter application to the clerk of the court explaining in detail good cause for the oversized submission and asserting that the brief has been edited to conciseness and to eliminate repetition. A copy of the proposed brief must accompany the letter.
